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Duct Tape Rose Flower Pen

Supplies: Green Duct Tape, Colored Duct Tape, Scissors, Clear Tubing size 5/16 x 1/2 -3/32 Wall-cut 2 1/2" long, Pen (Bic Round Medium), Box Cutter, & Cutting Board.

Pen - Cut tubing 2 1/2" long and slip over pen.

Flower Center - Cut (1) 1" green and cover end of tubing and pen.

Leaves - Cut (2) 5" green and fold down leaving 1" of sticky. Cut into leaf shape and set aside.



Rose- Round 1: Cut (6) 2" color duct tape strips. *Fold corner down leaving some sticky side. Fold other corner and secure leaving some sticky at bottom. Attach each petal to pen turning outside ends so petal turns out not up.*



Rose Round 2: Cut (7) 2 ½" color duct tape strips. *Repeat Round 1*

Rose Round 3: Cut (5) 3" color duct tape strips. *Repeat Round 1*

Rose Round 4: Cut a ½" color duct tape strip and wrap around base of flower to secure all the petals.

Leaves - Wrap the 2 green leaves to base of tubing on pen. Cut ½ "green duct tape and wrap around base of leaves to reinforce.



When your pen dries up you can remove the duct tape flower and replace it with a new pen.

Duct Tape Rose with Rounded Petals Pen

Supplies: Green Duct Tape, Colored Duct Tape, Scissors, Clear Tubing size 5/16 x 1/2 - 3/32 Wall-cut 2 1/2" long, Pen (Bic Round Medium), Box Cutter, & Cutting Board.

Pen - Cut tubing 2 1/2" long and slip over pen.

Flower Center - Cut (1) 1" green and cover end of tubing and pen.

Leaves - Cut (2) 5" green and fold down leaving 1" of sticky. Cut into leaf shape and set aside.



Rose Petals Round 1 - Cut (3) 3" Color strips for petals. *Fold down leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " – $\frac{1}{2}$ " sticky. Cut into a petal shape and attach to tubing/pen so you leave a little above the green center.*



Rose Petals Round 2 - Cut (5) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Color strips for petals. *Repeat Round 1*

Rose Petals Round 3 - Cut (4) 4" color strips for petals. *Repeat Round 1*


Rose Petals Round 4 – Cut (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " color strips for petals. *Repeat Round 1*

Leaves – attach the two leaves to the bottom of the tubing. Reinforce with a strip of $\frac{1}{2}$ " around the bottom of the leaves.



When your pen dries up you can remove the duct tape flower and replace with a new pen.

Duct Tape Mum Flower Pen

Supplies: Green Duct Tape, Colored Duct Tape, Scissors, Clear Tubing size 5/16 x 1/2 -3/32 Wall-cut 2 1/2" long, Pen (Bic Round Medium), Box Cutter, & Cutting Board.


Pen - Cut tubing 2 1/2" long and slip over pen.

Flower Center - Cut (1) 1" green and cover end of tubing and pen.

Leaves - Cut (2) 5" green and fold down leaving 1" of sticky. Cut into leaf shape and set aside.



Mum Round 1: Cut (3) 3" colored duct tape and *fold each down to 1" of sticky tape left, then fold colored end again and secure just past colored end leaving 1/2" of sticky.* Cut folded end with scissors so you have 6 petals. *Don't cut all the way through. Wrap each one around tip of pen.*



Mum Round 2: Cut (4) 4" colored duct tape. *Repeat Round 1* Cut folded end with scissors so you have 4 petals.



Mum Round 3: Cut (4) 4 1/2" colored duct tape. *Repeat Round 1* Cut folded end with scissors so you have 3 petals.

Mum Round 4: Cut a strip of colored duct tape and wrap around base of mum to reinforce petals.



Mum Round 5: Wrap green leaves to base of tubing on pen and secure with a ½" piece of green tape.



When your pen dries up you can remove the duct tape flower and replace it with a new pen.
